Job Description: An internship at The Texas Campaign to Prevent Teen Pregnancy is a prearranged, structured learning experience scheduled within a specific time frame. The experience must be relevant to the intern's academic and professional goals, and to the research and program activities of The Texas Campaign. An internship is performed under the direct supervision of Texas Campaign staff.

Communications and Media Intern duties include: curating daily news clips to send to staff members, drafting press releases, staying on top of trends in popular culture and the media industry; assisting in the planning and execution of meetings; writing about our issues for partners and colleagues; drafting social media language; some other administrative duties as assigned.

Qualifications: The ideal candidate will be currently working toward an undergraduate or advanced degree in Communications, Journalism, or related field. A passion for popular culture is essential as well as a strong interest in news, TV, movies, blogs, social media. Must have strong organizational skills and a good sense of humor as well as strong writing skills. We are looking for a self-starter who can solve problems creatively, multi-task productively, and pay meticulous attention to details.
