

Strategy Development Scope of Work US Programs Consultant

Background

EngenderHealth seeks to build upon its prior commitment with a renewed focus on service delivery, youth, policy and advocacy, training, and contraceptive security to empower women and girls as rights holders and to hold governments and providers accountable as duty bearers.

Under EngenderHealth's United States (US) Country Office, we are committed to developing innovative, science-based programs and curricula to improve sexual and reproductive health outcomes for young people while supporting youth serving organizations through capacity building training and technical assistance. We are committed to developing and supporting programs that engage young people as experts in their own lives and empower them to choose the life they want to live.

The US Country Office is developing a Country Strategy, aligned with EngenderHealth's organizational strategic plan (SP2020), that lays out the organization's commitment to women and girls from now until 2020. The strategy will include strategic objectives to reach girls where they are, bring SRHR to other sectors of society; program results including how youth are empowered, access to high quality, acceptable information and services; and incorporate objectives including raising income and investing in the organization.

Services

Consultant will support the development of a US Country Strategy based on SP2020 and a package of standardized country strategy planning templates provided. The process for developing the strategy will include:

- Complete a situational analysis for US with support from the local team including a desk review and interviews with key informants.
- Facilitate strategy development meetings with US team and HQ staff to inform the development of a draft country strategic plan based on SP2020
- Revise the strategic plan document based on input and feedback from the Project Director, other US staff, and HQ staff.
- Revise and finalize strategic plan and submit to the Project Director

From October 1st to November 1st 2017 for up to 20 days.
