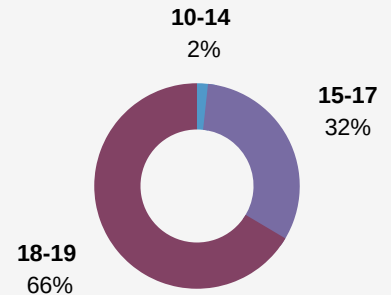

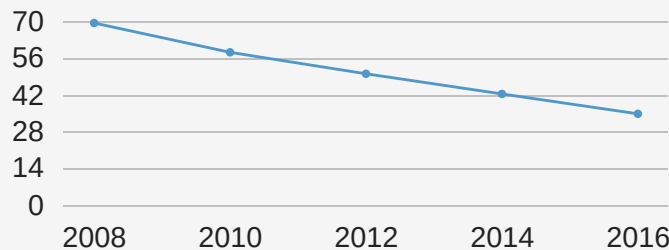
63% of 12th grade students have had sex.

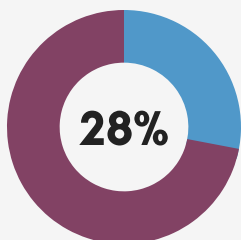

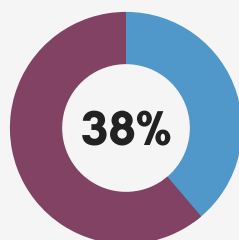
