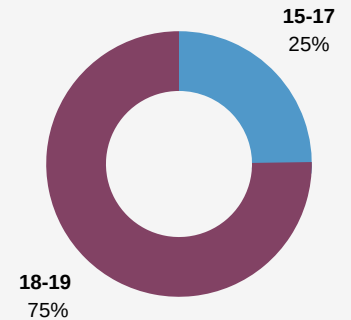

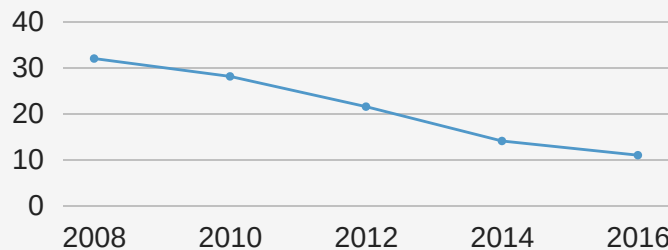

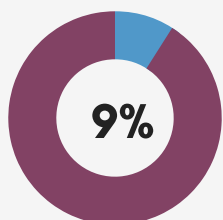
63% of 12th grade students have had sex.

Just 16% of school districts teach medically accurate sex education.

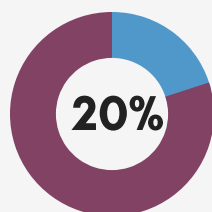
Teens under 18 who already have a baby can't consent to their own contraception under state law.
