Teens under 18 who already have a baby can't consent to their own contraception under state law.

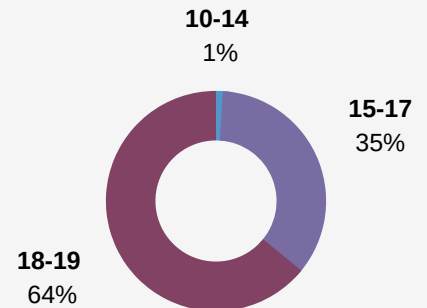
## Number of Teen Births, 2016

**Total Teen Births in Hidalgo County, 2016: 1,706**

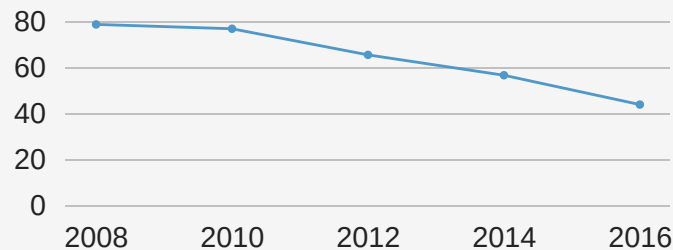
### Age of Mother

US:	<b>20.3</b>

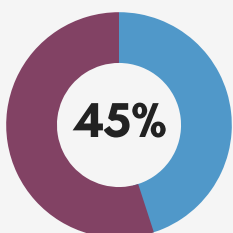

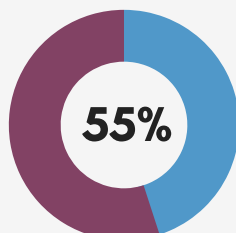
